



SUMMER TRUMPET ACADEMY PRZEMYŚL, POLAND 6 – 11 JULY 2026

REGULATIONS

1. The organizer of the Summer Trumpet Academy (hereinafter: STA) is the Salesian Organ School Foundation in Przemysł, registered at: Pl. bł. ks. Augusta Czartoryskiego 2, 37-700 Przemysł, NIP: 7952549978, REGON: 381039194, KRS: 0000743675, Bank BGŻ BNP Paribas S.A. 58 1600 1462 1879 7419 2000 0001.
2. The Director of STA is Dr. habil. Daniel Prajzner; the artistic and academic supervision of STA is exercised by Dr. habil. Tomasz Ślusarczyk.
3. STA is a series of workshop classes intended for pupils, students, graduates, and teachers of trumpet classes, as well as other individuals passionate about playing this instrument (e.g., members of various amateur ensembles or wind orchestras).
4. Workshop activities within STA include:
 - individual lessons in solo performance and orchestral studies (the organizer guarantees each participant 5 individual lessons, each lasting 30 minutes),
 - ensemble playing classes,
 - the possibility of passive participation in all lessons,
 - psychological consultations,
 - general physical development classes.
5. The classes will be conducted by the following teachers:

 - **Michał Tyrański** (Poland) – I.J. Paderewski Pomeranian Philharmonic in Bydgoszcz, F. Nowowiejski Academy of Music in Bydgoszcz;and supporting staff:
 - **Marcel Bich** (Poland) – J. Elsner Opole Philharmonic, M. Szymanowska State Primary Music School No. 2 in Kędzierzyn-Koźle, Public Primary Music School in Leśnica,
 - **Monika Morawiec** (Poland) – State Primary Music School in Zawiercie,
 - **Maksymilian Miczka** (Poland) – student of the K. Penderecki Academy of Music in Kraków,
 - **Jacek Kraus** (Poland) – Dr. J. Babiński Clinical Hospital in Kraków (psychologist),
 - **Nikodem Langer** (Poland) – student of Opole University of Technology (movement and general development classes).
6. During STA, concerts by soloists and ensembles as well as an orchestral studies competition will be held.
7. The goals of STA are:
 - promoting the art of trumpet playing,
 - acquiring and deepening knowledge, technical and performance skills, and competencies in solo and ensemble playing by pupils, students, graduates of art schools, and other trumpet enthusiasts,
 - exchanging experiences and integrating children, youth, and adults from various regions of Poland and abroad,
 - presenting talented trumpeters to a wide audience during concerts held in Przemysł,

- providing psychological support and developing proper movement habits necessary for daily practice and public performances.
8. STA will take place on **6–11 July 2026** at the Salesian School Complex in Przemyśl, Pl. bł. ks. Augusta Czarторыckiego 2 (**participant registration**: 6 July, 9:00–10:00; **opening**: 10:00; **closing**: 11 July, 13:00). The general schedule is published on the website: <https://www.sso-przemysl.pl/letnia-akademia-trabki/>.

Applications and Fees

9. Participation in STA can be registered exclusively online via the website (address in point 8), where **the application form** is available.
10. Adult participants must download from the registration form a document containing the required **declarations** (in particular: acknowledgment and acceptance of STA regulations, confirmation of having medical and accident insurance, consent to personal data processing), print it, complete it, sign it, and **submit it to the organizer before STA begins**, during participant registration on the arrival day, **in the original (not a copy)**. Failure to submit the required documents results in exclusion from participation.
11. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants; applications are accepted in order of submission.
12. **The participation fee is 700 PLN** per person. It must be paid by bank transfer (details in point 1) or in cash before STA begins, no later than the end of registration. Participants who fail to pay will not be admitted. The fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
13. If catering is reserved in the registration form, the organizer will provide it after payment (additional cost). **Full board** (breakfast, lunch, dinner) costs **80 PLN per day; lunch only – 40 PLN** per day. Payment must be made in cash during registration.
14. If accommodation is selected in the registration form, the organizer will reserve **accommodation** for the participant at the dormitory of the K. Morawski Secondary School No. II in Przemyśl (ul. Glazera 44, website: <https://lo2.przemysl.edu.pl/205/internat.html>). The cost is **60 PLN** per night (additional cost). Payment must be made in cash during registration. If places run out, the organizer will block the accommodation option in the form.
15. Participants who do not choose accommodation via the organizer must arrange it independently.

Participation Rules

16. The organizer is not responsible for participants' personal belongings, their loss, damage, or theft, nor for incidents resulting from non-compliance with the regulations.
17. The organizer reserves the right to exclude a participant in case of gross violation of the regulations, social norms, or creating danger to others. In such cases, the participant must leave STA immediately, and the fee is non-refundable.
18. Parents or legal guardians are responsible for damages caused by the underage participant, including material damages, and must cover the costs.

Underage Participants

19. **A parent or legal guardian supervises the child throughout STA and is responsible for them**, subject to points 22 and 23.
20. **Legal guardians (teachers) of organized groups supervise their charges throughout STA**, subject to points 22 and 23.
21. For underage participants, a document containing required **declarations and consents of the parent/legal guardian** must be downloaded from the registration form (including: acknowledgment and acceptance of STA regulations, consent for participation, consent for independent participation and movement—if applicable, consent for medical assistance, health information, confirmation of insurance, consent for data processing and image use). It must be printed, completed, signed, and **submitted in original form during registration**. Failure to submit it results in exclusion.
22. The organizer supervises underage participants only during workshop classes. Outside these hours, responsibility lies with the parent/legal guardian unless otherwise arranged under point 23.
23. **At the request of a parent/legal guardian, the organizer may provide supervision outside workshop hours**. Conditions are arranged individually and require phone or email contact at least one week before STA begins. This is

possible only if accommodation at the dormitory (point 14) was reserved during registration. Without prior arrangements, the organizer does not provide supervision.

24. Underage participants **may not leave classes or the venue without permission from the organizer or the designated supervising person.**
25. Parents/legal guardians must inform the organizer before STA begins about chronic illnesses, allergies, medications, and dosage.
26. Parents/legal guardians must maintain **constant phone contact with the organizer** during STA.
27. In case of illness or hospitalization, the parent/legal guardian **must take over care** within 12 hours of notification.

Participant Insurance

28. Every participant must have valid medical and accident insurance for the entire duration of STA. The organizer does not provide insurance and is not responsible for its absence. For participants from abroad, the minimum insurance coverage must be at least 50,000 EUR.

Health and Sanitary Rules

29. Only healthy individuals without symptoms suggesting infectious disease may participate.
30. If concerning symptoms appear (e.g., fever, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath), the participant or their guardian must immediately inform the organizer and, if necessary, withdraw from STA. The organizer may refuse participation or exclude the participant if symptoms occur.
31. The organizer remains in close contact with the District Sanitary and Epidemiological Station in Przemyśl.
32. Participants and teachers must comply with all announcements issued by the organizer, the District Sanitary and Epidemiological Station, and the Chief Sanitary Inspectorate.

Final Provisions

33. Matters not regulated herein are decided by the organizer in accordance with applicable law and the best interest of participants.
